Power of attorney

The Principal resp. the principal cardholder (hereinafter the "**Principal**") is the holder of a charge card or credit card issued by Swisscard AECS GmbH (hereinafter the "card"), **and until written revocation and within the scope of the Principal's rights, duties and obligations, hereby authorizes the above-mentioned financial intermediary**, its legal successors, directors, officers, employees and vicarious agents (hereinafter the "**Authorized Representative**") **to fully represent the Principal vis-à-vis Swisscard AECS GmbH and vis-à-vis the persons appointed by it to process the card business (hereinafter collectively the «Issuer») in accordance with the General Terms and Conditions (hereinafter the "GTC") of the Issuer that apply to the respective card product.** In this respect, the version of the GTC in effect at the time of the signing of the card application and/or the respective amendment shall apply.

Transfers of card credit balances to other accounts as well as new cards, however, can only be applied by the Principal personally (including, where applicable, the signing of a consumer loan agreement in the case of cards with an installment facility).

In the event of suspected fraud, the Issuer can, if necessary, directly contact the Principal in order to verify individual card transactions.

The Principal is aware that the Issuer and the Authorized Representative have the right and obligation to exchange with one another certain information in the context of the card relationships in connection with this Power of Attorney or to the extent required by law (e.g. in the context of money-laundering investigations). In such cases, the Principal shall release the Issuer and the Authorized Representative from any possible confidentiality obligations and authorizes them to exchange such information. Further information about data processing is contained in the Issuer's Privacy Policy, which may be viewed at any time at [swisscard.ch/en/legal-conditions-and-information](https://www.swisscard.ch/en/legal-conditions-and-information), or may also be requested from the Issuer.

This Power of Attorney shall also remain in effect in the event of the loss of legal capacity of the Principal, an official declaration of the Principal as a missing person, or the death of the Principal.

The Principal shall be liable to the Issuer for all acts or omissions of the Authorized Representative. The Principal shall acknowledge as duly authorized any person who authenticates themselves to the Issuer in accordance with the security characteristics agreed with the Authorized Representative (in particular, security code, secure email or postal mail).

Any and all legal claims arising out of or in connection with this Power of Attorney are to be exercised by the Principal directly and exclusively toward the Authorized Representative; **moreover, any liability on the part of the Issuer is expressly disclaimed insofar as this is legally permissible.**

The Principal is not entitled to return the Power of Attorney pursuant to Article 36 of the Swiss Code of Obligations (CO). **The GTC underlying the card relationship shall apply accordingly to the choice of law and place of jurisdiction.** The GTC may be viewed at [swisscard.ch/en/legal-conditions-and-information](https://www.swisscard.ch/en/legal-conditions-and-information) and may be requested from the Issuer.
